

NOTICE TO OWNERS/RESIDENTS

DRAINS/PLUMBING

With so many Residents at home, it is more important than ever that Residents take care to ensure the health of the building plumbing systems. Simply put, your drains (toilets and sinks) are not a replacement for compost/green bins or garbage cans.

It may become difficult to have trades people perform drainage work due to the additional risk associated with COVID-19. Residents absolutely must take extra care with the building plumbing equipment.

Do not flush ANY wipes down toilets (even if they are advertised as “flushable”). They will clog the drains and cause backups.

The following items **SHOULD NEVER** be flushed down the toilet:

- Personal care wipes/baby wipes
- Diapers
- Cotton swabs
- Hair
- Dental floss
- Tampons
- Sanitary products
- Condoms
- Old medicines
- Grease/fat from food
